<p><b><u>Reading EXS:</u></b> No pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in Reading which is 63 percentage points below the national average of 63% and 70 percentage points below the Barnet average of 70%</p> <p><b><u>Reading GDS:</u></b> No pupils with Pupil Premium were working at greater depth in Reading which is 14 percentage points below the average of 14% and 14 percentage points below the Barnet average of 14%</p> <p><b><u>Writing EXS:</u></b> No pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in Writing which is 55 percentage points below the national average of 55% and 64 percentage points below the Barnet average of 64%</p> <p><b><u>Writing GDS:</u></b> No pupils with Pupil Premium were working at greater depth in Writing which is 8 percentage points below the national average of 8% and 9 percentage points below the Barnet average of 9%.</p> <p><b><u>Maths EXS:</u></b> 50% pupils on Pupil Premium were working at expected standard in Maths which is 13 percentage points below the national average of 63% and 21 percentage points below the Barnet average of 71%.</p> <p><b><u>Maths GDS:</u></b> No pupils with Pupil Premium were working at greater depth which is 12 percentage points below the national average of 12% and 13 percentage points below the Barnet average of 13%.</p> <p><b><u>Reading, Writing and Maths EXS:</u></b> No pupils with Pupil Premium were working at expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths combined which is 50 percentage points below the national average of 50% and 57 percentage points below the Barnet average of 57%.</p> <p><b><u>Reading, Writing and Maths GDS:</u></b> No pupils with Pupil Premium were working below in greater depth in Reading, Writing and Maths which is 5 percentage points below the national average of 5% and 7 percentage points below the Barnet average of 7%.</p>

<p><b><u>Reading EXS:</u></b> 83% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in Reading which is 3 percentage points above the national average of 80% and 9 percentage points above the Barnet average of 74%.</p>

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### Comparison between the achievement for disadvantaged pupils at school and nationally

#### 2018 KS2

**Reading HIGH:** 33% pupils with Pupil Premium were working HIGH at Reading which is equal to the percentage points at the national average of 33% and 10 percentage points above the Barnet average of 22%.

**Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling EXS:** 83% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in GPS which is 1 percentage points above the national average of 82% and 6 percentage points above the Barnet average of 77%.

**Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling HIGH:** 67% pupils with Pupil Premium were working HIGH at GPS which is 28 percentage points above the national average of 39% and 32 percentage points above the Barnet average of 35%.

**Writing EXS:** 67% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in Writing which is 16 percentage points below the national average of 83% and 6 percentage points below the Barnet average of 73%.

**Writing GDS:** 17% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at greater depth standard in Writing which is 7 percentage points below the national average of 24% and 6 percentage points above the Barnet average of 11%.

**Maths EXS:** 67% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at expected standard in Maths which is 14 percentage points below the national average of 81% and 8 percentage points below the Barnet average of 75%.

**Maths HIGH:** 33% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at HIGH in Maths which is 5 percentage points above the national average of 28% and 14 percentage points above the Barnet average of 19%.

**Reading, Writing, Maths EXS:** 67% pupils with pupil premium were working at expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths which is 3 percentage points below the national average of 70% and 5 percentage points above the Barnet average of 62%.

**Reading, Writing, Maths HIGH:** No pupils with Pupil Premium were working at Reading, Writing and Maths HIGH which is 12 percentage points below the national average of 12% and 5 percentage points below the Barnet average of 5%.
