THE SCHOOL

We will aim to:

- a) Engender in our pupils a sense of responsibility for themselves, the Jewish community and the wider community.
- b) We will encourage children to do acts of chesed (kindness) to each other and to all adults in and out of school and promote this through the weekly newsletter and Head Teacher's Politeness and Kindness Awards.
- b) Achieve high standards of work and behaviour in a safe and caring environment.
- c) Provide a balanced and stimulating curriculum which meets the needs of each child, ensuring that they reach their full potential.
- d) Keep you regularly informed about general school matters and about your child's progress.
- e) Inform you annually at the Curriculum Information Evening about the year's curriculum.

THE PARENT:

I will aim to:

- a) Ensure that my child attends school regularly, punctually and properly dressed and equipped. My child's hair will be neatly groomed and boys' hair will not be overly long.
- b) Adhere to the school's dress code when on the school site (dress code is on the website)
- c) Advise the school in writing about any absence
- d) Support the school's policies and guidelines of behavior
- e) Engage with the professional staff at school in an appropriate manner when discussing aspects of my child's education
- f) Attend Parent Evenings and inform the school of any circumstances that might affect my child's work.
- g) Read and sign my child's Homework diary/Home link book and support my child's homework.

THE CHILD:

I will aim to:

- a) Attend school regularly and on time, bringing all that I need for the day with me
- b) I will learn about the Golden Rules of the school and do my best to follow them (The Golden Rules are below)
- c) Do all my classwork and homework as well as I possibly can
- d) Be kind, honest and helpful, respecting others' differences and points of view
- e) Keep myself clean and tidy in correct school uniform and be responsible for looking after my own property
- f) Keep the school free from litter and damage

TOGETHER:

Together we will aim to

- a) Actively support the Jewish values and ethos of the school

- b) Work in a partnership to support the children's learning to help them achieve their best
- c) Help to make the school a happy and safe place for everyone
