<p><b><u>Reading EXS:</u></b> 100% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in Reading, which is 22 percentage points above the national average of 78%.</p> <p><b><u>Reading HIGH:</u></b> 25% pupils with Pupil Premium were working HIGH at Reading, which is 6 percentage points below the national average of 31%.</p> <p><b><u>Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling EXS:</u></b> 100% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in GPS, which is 17 percentage points above the national average of 83%.</p> <p><b><u>Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling HIGH:</u></b> 50% pupils with Pupil Premium were working HIGH at GPS, which is 9 percentage points above the national average of 41%.</p> <p><b><u>Writing EXS:</u></b> 100% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in Writing, which is 17 percentage points above the national average of 83%.</p> <p><b><u>Writing HIGH:</u></b> 25% pupils with Pupil Premium were working HIGH in Writing, which is 1 percentage points above the national average of 24%.</p> <p><b><u>Maths EXS:</u></b> 75% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard, which is 9 percentage points below the national average of 84%.</p> <p><b><u>Maths HIGH:</u></b> 0% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at HIGH in Maths, which is 32 percentage points below the national average of 32%.</p> <p><b><u>Reading, Writing and Maths EXS:</u></b> 75% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths, which is 4 percentage points above the national average of 71%.</p> <p><b><u>Reading, Writing and Maths HIGH:</u></b> 0% pupils with Pupil Premium were working at Reading, Writing and Maths HIGH, which is 13 percentage points below the national average of 13%.</p>
