School Uniform Policy

It is our Policy that all children wear Rosh Pinah Primary School's Official Uniform when attending school or when representing the school in an organised event outside normal school hours.

As well as being practical and smart, we believe that a Uniform Policy will:-

- Reinforce a positive learning environment
- Promote a unified school spirit
- Inspire a sense of pride in our School.
- Identify pupils with the school
- Support the school's commitment to inclusion
- Prevent pupils from wearing 'fashion clothes' that could be distracting in class
- Be practical, smart, and designed with health and safety in mind
- Be considered as good value for money

It is important that all items of uniform are clearly marked with your child's name.

Items marked below with an * must be purchased from UNIFORM4KIDS. Kippot, book bags and PE bags are purchased online via SIMS Pay and can be collected from the School office. All other items can be bought in supermarkets or other uniform shops.

Nursery

Children in our Nursery are asked to wear uniform tops with comfortable tracksuit bottoms or other comfortable Nursery wear.

Hair and Hair Accessories

Boys' hair should be collar length. Hair should not fall into the eyes and clips hairbands or bandanas are not permitted to keep hair out of the eyes or to be worn as fashion items.

Girls' hair should be neat and long hair tied back. Hair bands, ribbons/bows or 'scrunchies' should be blue to match our uniform. Hair bands should not have large flowers or other decoration attached.

Extreme hairstyles are not appropriate for school nor is the use of styling products. Children should not have decorative patterns cut into their hair or have hair coloured or dyed.

Jewellery

We do not allow children to wear jewellery. The exceptions to this rule are ear-ring studs in pierced ears for girls.

Children will be required to remove studs during P.E. lessons to prevent them from causing injury and we strongly advise that studs are not worn on the day that your child is timetabled to have PE.

Please note: Teachers are not permitted to remove earrings.

Make-up and Nail Varnish

Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school.

The Role of Parents

One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that it is clean, in good repair and that the child's name is visibly labelled on all items. If a parent has difficulties for any reason with fulfilling this request, they are asked to speak confidentially to a senior member of staff to discuss the issues. Parents should be assured that we will do all we can to help.

Parents of children who arrive at School wearing non-school uniform clothing will be required to send in a note to the Class Teacher or email the School Office with an explanation. Parents may be contacted to discuss the matter.

The Role of Governors

The Governing Body supports the Headteacher in implementing the School's Uniform Policy and considers all representations from parents regarding the Policy.
